In Traditional Design, cabinetry tends to be more elaborate than in Contemporary styling. The doors will have a center raised panel or extra moldings. Crown and Toe Kick details will be stepped up or given more of a furniture look. Countertops are typically found with an Ogee or Mitered edge.

Contemporary Design is clean with straight lines. Slab or flat front doors fit the look in high gloss finishes or wood like textured laminates. Countertops have waterfall sides or 3/4" thick slabs.

Transitional Design is the marriage of both Contemporary and Traditional design. It offers clean and practical lines, such as a shaker style in a stained or painted finish. Transitional design showcases a blend of natural and man-made materials and a color palette of neutral colors.

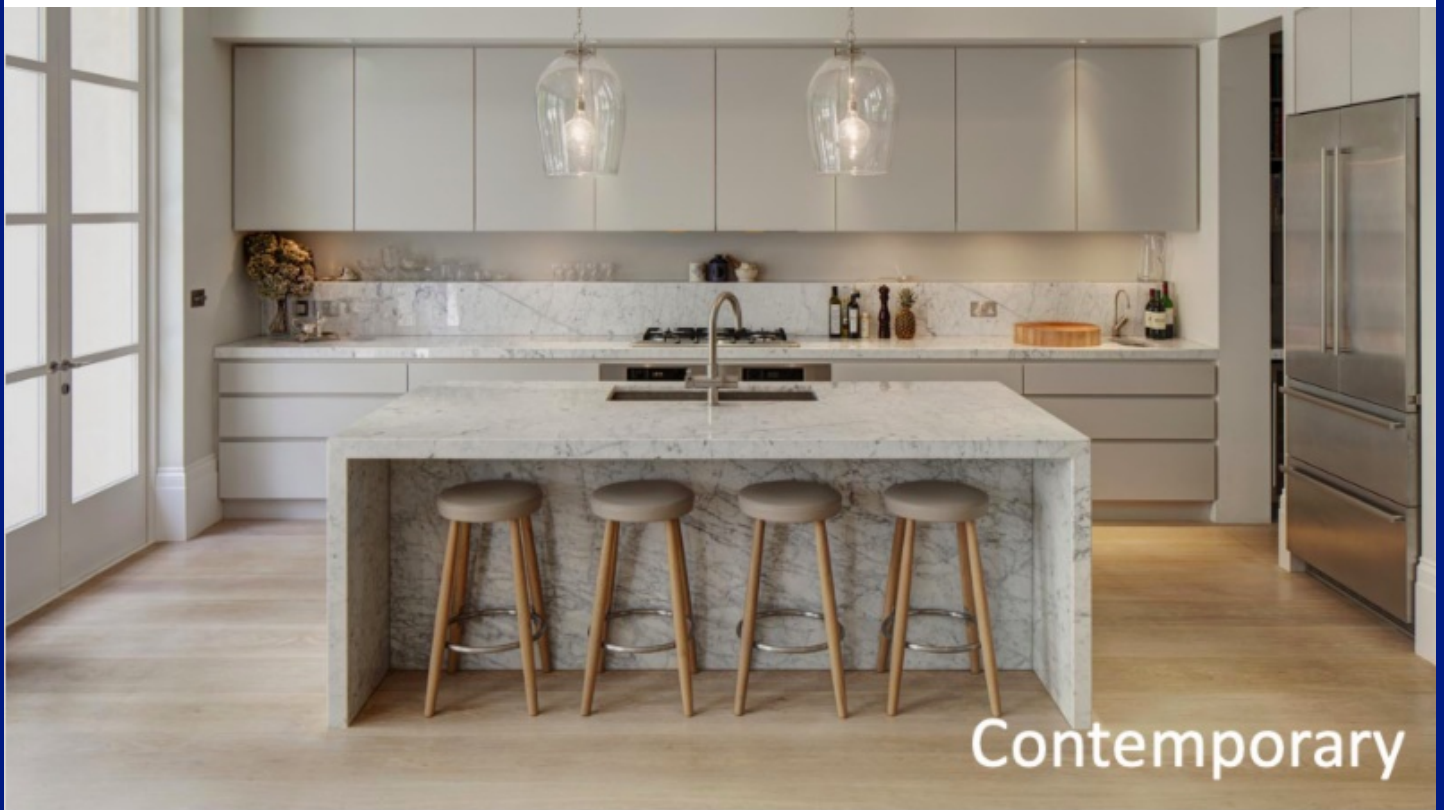
